To begin answering the catechism questions from last week's bulletin:

1. Who is God?

The Creator of all that exists who is in Himself uncreated and eternal. God is One yet, in mystery, three Divine Persons: The Will of God, The Word of God and The Love of God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

2. Who are the Angels?

Spiritual beings created by God in His service. They behold the vision of God and share in His glory.

3. What is the soul?

The human person, immediately created by God, in the image of God that is immortal (does not perish).

4. Why did God make you? To know Him, to love Him, to serve Him and to be with Him forever.

5. What is sin? An utterance, deed or desire contrary to the love and law of God. An offense against reason, truth and right conscience; it is a failure in genuine love for God and neighbor.

6. What is original sin? By disobedience to God Adam and Eve lost the original holiness and justice they had received from God. This loss of Sanctifying Grace is transmitted to their descendants and is called original sin.

7. What is actual sin?

There are two kinds of sin: Original sin and Actual sin. Actual sin is the offenses we commit by our own free will; called either venial or mortal sin.

8. What is venial sin? A wound to God's love. Venial sin slows the souls progress of virtue and the practice of moral good. Venial sin does not set one in direct opposition to the will and friendship with God yet, it is something we should confess and not take lightly. (see 1 John 5:16-17)

9. What is mortal or grave sin? According to the Catechism, sin is rightly evaluated according to their gravity. Mortal sin is a turning away from God. It is an attack on the vital principle of charity and the privation of sanctifying grace. Such sin, if not repentant of in the Sacrament of Confession, could mean the exclusion from God's kingdom.

10. What three things are necessary for a sin to be Mortal? Such sin requires full knowledge and consent of the will. 1) It must be grave matter such as a direct disregard for the Commandments.

2) One must know the seriousness of the matter. 3) One must freely choose to commit the sin.
