11. Can you list the Ten Commandments? 1)I am the Lord your God you shall not have strange gods before me. 2)You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain. 3)Keep holy the Sabbath Day. 4)Honor your father and your mother. 5)You shall not kill. 6)You shall not commit adultery. 7)You shall not steal. 8)You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. 9)You shall not covet your neighbor's wife. 10)You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.
12. What does the word "catholic" mean? A Greek word for universal.
13. What are the four marks of the Church? **One-** Jesus started only one Church. **Holy-** Jesus is Holy. **Catholic-** The Church is for everyone. **Apostolic-** The Church was founded on the Apostles.
14. Who did Jesus first put in charge of His Church? **Peter**
15. Who is the successor of Saint Peter today? **Pope Francis**
16. What are the Sacraments? Outward signs instituted by Christ to give Grace. They are: **Baptism, Reconciliation, Confirmation, Holy Eucharist, Marriage, Holy Orders, Anointing of the Sick**
17. What is meant by the Redemption of Jesus Christ? The Divine Plan of Salvation. Here we speak of the Paschal Mystery of Christ's Cross and Resurrection; the "Good News" of God's saving plan is accomplished once and for all by the redemptive death of Jesus.
18. What is meant by the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass? It is the mystery of Christ's saving act when he offered Himself as the sacrificial lamb at the last supper. "He took bread, said the blessing, broke it and said, 'This is my body which will be given for you; do this in memory of me.' And after they had eaten saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you.'" Jesus is the Sacrificial Lamb offered once and for all at the Last Supper yet, each Mass is like an "echo" of that Sacred Meal. As He offers Himself, not again and again but, in mystery as we recall His words and share in His one offering of Himself as the Lamb on the Altar of Sacrifice; on the Cross.
