Continuing with the questions every Confirmed Catholic should know:

26. What is the Rosary?

A popular form of prayer combined with meditation on the life, ministry and Passion of our Lord. Originally consisting of fifteen mysteries encompassing our Lord's earthly life with the last two mysteries focused on Mary's Ascension into Heaven and Her Coronation as Queen of Heaven and Earth. Saint Pope John Paul II introduced five new meditation mysteries called the Mysteries of Light which focus on our Lord's public ministry and the institution of the Most Holy Eucharist.

The Rosary was proclaimed and spread through the preaching of Saint Dominic who lived from 1170 to 1221. Legend tells us that Dominic received the Rosary meditation from Mary Herself during an apparition in 1214 as a means of grace to combat the Albigensian heresy that had spread it false teaching through much of France and Spain in the Middle Ages.

27. Can you name the mysteries of the Rosary? Annunciation, Visitation, Birth of Jesus, Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, Finding of Jesus in the Temple, Baptism of Jesus by John, Wedding Feast of Cana, Announcing the Kingdom of God, Transfiguration, Institution of the Holy Eucharist, Agony in the Garden, Scourging at the pillar, Crowning of Thorns, Carrying the Cross, Crucifixion, Resurrection, Ascension, Decent of the Holy Spirit to the Apostles, Assumption of Mary into Heaven, Coronation of Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth.

28. What do we call the mystery of God becoming Man? This is called the Incarnation. When Jesus was conceived in the womb of Mary, the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity became truly man while remaining truly God. As Saint John says at the beginning of his Gospel, (1:14) "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us." He possesses two natures, one divine and the

other human united in one person. Throughout Christian history many have tried to explain this in human terms only to fall into heresy by denying Jesus' divinity or His humanity. The best we can do is spelled out in the Nicene Creed, "Eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made one in being with the Father..." This is a mystery that we cannot fully comprehend now in this life but, possibly understood more fully in Heaven.
