**Continuing with the questions every Confirmed Catholic should know:**

### **29. When you were born did you have a share in God's life?**

Because of original sin, the disobedience of our first parents, and the subsequent loss of God's Divine favor or Sanctifying Grace, human nature is deprived of original holiness and justice. (Catechism #404) Thus, we are not born into this world with God's life of grace in us and we do not have a share in God's life. That is until, thanks to God's gift of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, this Grace is restored to us in Baptism.

### **30. Do we have a share in God's life now?**

Yes, in Baptism God's Saving Grace is restored to us and we now have a share in Divine Life.

### **31. Do we believe we are saved?**

As we recite in the Creed, "We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come." We are taught from our earliest years, the restoration of Sanctifying Grace through Baptism makes us adopted children of God. We become temples of the Holy Spirit; holy and pleasing to God. And in this we have the offer and right to heaven. Yet, we are also taught that our salvation can be lost through sin and rejection of God as Saint Paul strongly states in Romans 2:4-8. And Saint John in his first letter 5:16-17, speaks of praying for sinners and mentions that there is such a thing as deadly sin. He does not elaborate on this yet, our Holy Mother Church teaches us about mortal or deadly sin that blocks God's Grace and destroys the love of God within us. Of course this "connection" to God's Grace is restored through repentance and the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Given God's gift of Sanctifying Grace we must always cherish that treasure "pearl of great price" (Mt:13:46) and strive always to protect it by a life of faithful devotion, service and virtue.

**32. What is necessary for salvation?** As Jesus says to His Apostles, recorded in Mark 16:16, "Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved..." And in John 3:36, "Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life... The Catechism says, "Faith is both a gift from God and a personal adherence to God who reveals Himself to us. It involves an assent of the intellect and will to God through ones words and deeds." Believing is a human act that is conscious and free to adhere to the Truths taught by God. Faith, belief - Salvation consists of follow His ways, adhering to His Truths - seeking always what is pleasing to God as Temples of the Holy Spirit. Good references are the parable story Jesus tells of the Judgement of the Nations as given in Matthew 25:34-40 and James 2:20.
