As you know, Holy Week is our most solemn week of the year beginning with our Lord's entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. This week demands of us our focus and participation. During this week we recall the fulfillment of God's Promise of Redemption and the sobering realization of the cost of our sins, and those of the whole world. The sacrifice and ransom Almighty God's perfect Justice demands, to restore us to Sanctifying Grace is no less than the offering of His Divine Son.

This is a Holy Week of gratitude and re-dedication to our Lord and Savior, a gratitude that must extend itself and be expressed every day of our lives thus, making real the re-dedication of our lives

to our Creator and God. I hope you all will make a sacrificial effort out of love and gratitude, to make a good Confession and participate in the Holy Week celebrations.

From a homily on Holy Week by Saint Gregory Nazianzen, bishop: (page 392)

"We are soon going to share in the Passover, and although we still do so only in a symbolic way, the symbolism already has more clarity than it possessed in former times because, under the law, the Passover was, if I may dare to say so, only a symbol of a symbol. So let us take our part in the Passover, not in a literal way but according to the teaching of the Gospel. Let us regard as our home the heavenly Jerusalem, not the earthly city.

We are not required to sacrifice beasts with horns and hoofs.... [Rather,] let us join the choirs of angels in offering to God upon His heavenly altar a sacrifice of praise; ourselves, each day and in everything we do, accepting all that happens to us for the sake of the Word, imitating His Passion in our sufferings. Take up your cross and follow Christ and, like the good thief, acknowledge your God

For our sake, and because of our sin, Christ Himself was regarded as a sinner. For His sake therefore, we must cease to sin. Make your own [cross] the expiation of the sins of the whole world. Worship Him who was hung on the cross. Contemplate the glories of paradise and be the first to see the stone rolled back, even the angels perhaps, and Jesus Himself."
